Once you have received the light, please hold your upright lit candle as the next person obtains the light from you and continue to hold your candle upright through the singing of Silent Night. After the sanctuary lights return, please extinguish your candle, being careful not to tilt it until the liquid wax solidifies. When you leave the sanctuary, you may place your candle in the baskets provided.
