Can you believe Christmas is Monday? It feels like time sped up and this year just rushed past us. Las Posadas was created as a form for Spaniards to teach Native Americans about Christmas. The word Posadas translates to inn or lodging. Even though piñatas are more commonly seen at birth-day parties, they were actually created for the Posada Christmas. These piñatas were shaped like stars with 7 points, symbolizing the 7 deadly sins that were broken as soon Mary and Joseph were given shelter. In addition to piñatas, there is a reenactment of the journey of Mary and Joseph, and the children who are involved get to dress like Mary, Joseph, an angel, and in other biblical attire while the adults follow behind.

This year we made it a point to involve the children who participate in Midweek Manna, as well as give an opportunity for families who cannot always participate on weekends to join us. Therefore on Wednesday, December 13 we had the opportunity of having our own Posadas. We expected the Midweek Manna kids and maybe a few of their parents and siblings. We were definitely not expecting there to be a lot more participants or that the food that the parents of our midweek mana kids had brought would run out. This festivity was a great way to incorporate and share a tradition with both our Midweek families and Lakesiders.
