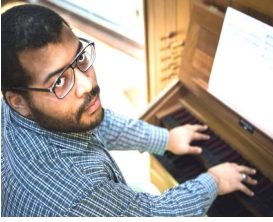

There are few pieces in the modern choral repertoire that embody the spirit and fulfill this ultimate exhortation of Psalm 150 quite like Dr. Keith Hampton's (b. 1957) *Praise His Holy Name!*.

{Warmth of harmonic language, allusions to formative hymn texts, and rhythmic verve converge in Dr. Hampton's musical doxology and invite us to praise the Lord with all that we are and all that we have.}

Composed in 1991 for the Chicago-based community chorus Voices of Melody (of which Hampton was then conductor), the piece was recommended for publication by earthsongs by Dr. Anton Armstrong (the first conductor of color for the St. Olaf Choir, {one of the premier collegiate ensembles of the world}) in 1998 as part of Armstrong's choral music series with the firm. In 1999, during St. Olaf's performance at the American Choral Directors Association's national conference in Chicago, Armstrong made the decision mid-performance to substitute the planned concert closer with *Praise His Holy Name!*. This national exposure was a boon for the piece, and even resulted in earthsongs setting up a special hotline to deal with orders and inquiries specifically related thereto.

As you listen, you are invited to celebrate God and his goodness by clapping, swaying, tapping your foot, and moving (figuratively and literally) as the Spirit leads you as we all recall that final verse of Psalm 150; “**Let every thing that hath breath praise the LORD. Praise ye the LORD.**”
