

I find that I both love and hate the season of Lent. (Okay, maybe hate is too strong of a word; I certainly become frustrated with the season of Lent.) I love Lent because this forty-day reminder of Jesus' time in the wilderness invites and beckons us to slow down, consider our attitudes and practices and discern the ways that our lives have mysteriously wandered from the path Jesus is traveling. I become frustrated with Lent because when I begin to slow down, too often I discover that I am either roaming in a broad forest glade or struggling waist deep in a thorny thicket only to look up and neither Jesus nor the path are anywhere in sight.

Perhaps the challenge with Lent is that we desperately need to slow down, but we don't like what we find when we accept the invitation to pause. We want to be more faithful disciples of Jesus, but we don't want to do the uncomfortable work of self-discovery that will lead to spiritual growth. I am the first to admit that spiritual growth is neither easy nor free. Deep spiritual growth requires three things: 1) that we risk the pain of discovering the truth about ourselves; 2) admit we don't have the inherent power or the inclination to commit to the work of change: and finally 3) ask God to do for us what we cannot and will not do for ourselves.

In one of my daily devotionals Monday morning, I was invited to meditate on Jesus' words from Luke 6:36-38. <sup>436</sup> Be merciful, just as your Father is merciful. <sup>37</sup> "Do not judge, and you will not be judged; do not condemn, and you will not be condemned. Forgive, and you will be forgiven; <sup>38</sup> give, and it will be given to you. A good measure, pressed down, shaken together, running over, will be put into your lap, for the measure you give will be the measure you get back."

First, I reflected on the people who have extended mercy to me. When had I deserved judgment, condemnation and punishment and instead received grace and forgiveness? Next, I considered the people to whom I had refused or was refusing to extend mercy. I thought about several of our sermon Scripture passages lately that have also warned us that we will only receive God's forgiveness to the extent that we forgive others. Yikes! I always feel like God really wants me to get and embody a message when I receive it from several unrelated sources.

As long as we have breath, we have the opportunity to grow more and more into the likeness of Jesus. We do not enter the Kingdom of God through a wide gate but a narrow one.

I invite you to spend some time with the Luke 6:36-38 Scripture passage above. Ask God to bring to mind the people or situations which you need to forgive and release. If you are reluctant, ask God to make you willing to be willing. Ask the Holy Spirit to free you of a judging and condemning attitude so that you may practice mercy and forgiveness and live a transformed life as a faithful follower of Jesus Christ. Pastor Judy
