"New Year New You!" "New Year = A New Life" (Anthony Robbins) "New year — a new chapter, new verse, or just the same old story? Ultimately we write it. The choice is ours." (Alex Morritt) No matter what slogan comes to mind, the new year often brings with it the anticipation of reformed habits and practices that will improve our lives. Exercise, healthier food, commitment to reading the Bible or praying are among the "resolutions" we often make to enhance the new year. These are some of the things that we can affirm, either from personal experience or through witnessing others' lives, have the power and potential to enrich our own lives.

If you are among the 80 plus percent of people who have abandoned their resolutions by February in years gone by, chances are you may have learned to avoid this disappointment by just not making a resolution. No commitment to change or transformation results in no disappointment when you fail to bring the resolution to fruition.

I ceased making New Year's resolutions quite some time ago. However, that does not mean I do not take inventory of my life at key transition times of the year: New Year, Lent, Eastertide, back to school, and Advent. I want to identify what is missing in my life and what the Holy Spirit is inviting me to adapt, adopt or release to enrich my spiritual condition. Unfortunately, identifying what is needed and resolving to do something about it, are not the same as actually doing something about it! We must respond to the Holy Spirit's nudges with actions. We cannot allow inertia, fear, or good intentions to rob us of the fulfillment that God knows we need for a richer relationship with our Creator and neighbors. ". . . for God did not give us a spirit of cowardice but rather a spirit of power and of love and of self-discipline." 2 Timothy 1:7.

One of my responses to the Holy Spirit's nudges in this new year is to preach on the Apostles Creed and to offer small group studies on "What We Believe." After first Covid and then disaffiliation, many of us may find ourselves emotionally and spiritually isolated. Isn't it time we come together around our common faith? Isn't it time we reacquaint ourselves with the beliefs and traditions as Christians and United Methodists that nurture, strengthen and equip us?

Whether in-person or online, I pray that most of our Lakeside friends and family will reaffirm their commitment to Jesus, one another and our neighbors by being a part of a small group study. 
