

Music is powerful. It has the power to evoke memories, the power to make us cry, the power to move us to action. I think of the many families I have helped to plan funeral services and the variety of hymns they have selected to represent their loved ones. I remember the times I heard beautiful choral services that absolutely moved me to tears. And I recall contemporary Christian songs that have inspired me to be the first to raise my hands in praise or have led me to forgive someone who has hurt me. Music is powerful.

On Maundy Thursday this week, you have the opportunity to allow music to lead you through Christ's final days. Our amazingly gifted choir will present "The Shadow of the Cross" Tenebrae service. In this service the power of song and light guide us on our journey with Jesus to the cross. Join us as we celebrate Holy Communion and remember Jesus' Last Supper with his disciples. Let the dimming of the lights in the sanctuary as each candle is extinguished pull you into the depths of darkness that Jesus' followers experienced as they witnessed their beloved leader - the one they believed to be the Messiah - tried, tortured, crucified and buried.

As followers of Jesus, as people who claim to be his disciples, will you walk with him this Holy Week? Will you put yourself in a place to feel the betrayal and the heart-wrenching agony of abandonment that our Lord and Savior felt? Will you accept the truth of your sinful nature and ask Jesus for forgiveness through the power of music and light?

Words are powerful! Just as music and light have the power to evoke emotions and responses, words also have the power to change and transform us. We all know the power of the inspired Word of God - the Bible! In addition to the opportunity for music and light to guide you through Jesus' final hours on Maundy Thursday, you also have an opportunity on Friday to spend some reflective silence with Jesus at the Good Friday prayer stations. From 4:00 - 6:00 pm, there will be four prayer stations set up in the front of the sanctuary. They will invite you to: 1) consider Jesus' prayers and care for you; 2) recall times and ways that you have denied or betrayed Jesus; 3) pray for people or situations around the world; and 4) reflect upon the pain and significance of Jesus' crown of thorns. You may spend as much or as little time as you feel called to spend with Jesus on this day that we remember his crucifixion. death and burial.

Come and walk this lonesome valley with Jesus in his final hours so that you may more fully know the joy of his resurrection on Easter!

Easter Sonrise Service This Sunday at 7:00am. Meet us in the north parking lot with your coffee and lawn chairs for a special time of celebration.




