

Almost five years ago, I found myself in the grasp of the deepest, darkest abyss that I felt had no bottom. I couldn't breathe deep enough to keep from drowning. I couldn't scream loud enough to wake myself from a horrible nightmare. My prayers, and those of a multitude of others had gone unanswered. No one could provide a sufficient reason as to why my best friend, my heart, my soul, my music and the love of my life had been ripped from my very being; not my church, my faith, nor my God. I wanted and needed answers that no one seemed to be able to provide to my satisfaction. My solution seemed simple. Since I felt God had abandoned me, then I would abandon God.

For the next few years, I closed myself off in that dark place, convinced that no one could possibly understand my grief and pain. I didn't want to hear the typical insensitive platitudes that are often offered to those who are grieving, so I kept my distance. Covid became a really good excuse to avoid contact with anyone.

Then, with a nudge from a former church friend, I experienced a few "God Moments" that helped to get me back on track. One of those moments, was visiting with Pastor Judy and feeling the Holy Spirit working here at Lakeside UMC through its loving membership. I had lost my church and church family in the disaffiliation process....another death that I couldn't understand and another question "WHY" that had no good answer. Grief was taking its toll in my life and I needed help. I received it here at LUMC, my new church home and church family.



Pastor Judy, realizing the need for a ministry to help those suffering from a loss, contacted Pulaski Heights UMC about a program being offered called, Walking the Mourner's Path "transforming grief into joyful living", for those who were feeling led to help others grow spiritually through their own personal grieving process. Alicia Frye and I attended the program several weeks ago. We learned how to be caring and effective listeners and to be ever mindful that God is with us in our pain and sorrow. This type of program will be beneficial to our church and our community. Recovering from grief is difficult but what better way to begin than through a Christ-Centered Grief Ministry where you learn that you are not

alone. Plans are being formulated to begin such a program after Easter, so be prayerful and watch the newsletter for more information.

SUMMARY OF FEBRUARY 27. 2024 LEADERSHIP BOARD MEETING

- The January minutes, the financial and endowment reports, the Trustees' report and the consent calendar were reviewed and approved.
- The Board agreed with Pastor Judy's proposal to create an endowment task force to consider ways to encourage and promote endowment giving, including an endowment campaign. Pastor Judy is to contact suggested people to be on the task force.
- In the Pastor's report, Pastor Judy advised of a grief recovery group which will be offered at the church after Easter by Donna Kriner and Alicia Frye who were recently trained in the "Walking the Mourners' Path" grief recovery program. Pastor Judy's recommendation to form a task force to create Leadership Board guidelines and review and update all existing church policies to be presented for approval by the Leadership Board was approved.
- Townhall meetings and potlucks for 2024 are scheduled for March 24th, July 14th and November 17th.
