I am so very proud to serve at Lakeside United Methodist Church in Pine Bluff, Arkansas! In the midst of denominational turmoil, political discord and declining church attendance, the people of Lakeside have been keeping the main thing the main thing – making disciples of Jesus Christ for the transformation of the world.

We recently received a letter from Rev. Sam Meadors celebrating the incredible ministry of PT Arkansas that occurred at the Lakeside and St. Luke campuses this summer. Below is an excerpt from her letter and a few of the Lakeside statistics she shared with us.

Lakeside UMC,

Thank you so much for supporting Project Transformation with your prayers, presence, and gifts this summer. I wanted you to know the impact of that support.

This summer 50 children in Kindergarten to 6th grade participated in summer camp across two sites. We distributed over 1800 meals and 900 snacks. Collectively, students read for nearly 54,500 minutes through the summer. Despite having 66% of participants below grade level in reading, 84% maintained or improved their reading over the course of the program. . . .

It took many congregations working together to support these children and their young adult leaders. Nearly 120 individual volunteers served with us this summer as reading and dinner volunteers – including many from Lakeside. In fact, Lakeside volunteers provided the most meals during the summer on top of being hosts for family fun nights and reading buddies. . . .
